STATEMENT ISSUED ON 22^{ND} JULY 2022 BY THE ZICA CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, MR. ANTHONY BWEMBYA ON THE RELEASE OF THE JUNE 2022 ZICA EXAMINATIONS RESULTS.

RELEASE OF THE JUNE 2022 ZICA EXAMINATIONS RESULTS

It is my honor and pleasure to preside over the release of the June 2022 examination results for the Chartered Accountant Zambia (CA Zambia), Diploma in Accountancy programmes, Diploma in Public Sector Financial Management and Taxation qualifications. This is the fifth week since the examinations were held and I therefore, congratulate all members of staff at the Institute and our strategic partners in the examination process for the hard work resulting in the release of these results.

In line with the Accountants Act of 2008, our mandate is to regulate the education and training of accountancy professionals required by various sectors of our economy and to contribute positively to our nation's socio-economic development by providing accountants that are market ready to play the crucial role of leading businesses in both the private and public sectors.

On behalf of the ZICA Council and Management, the Institute wishes to thank Management and the lecturers of the approved Universities and Colleges, for the job well done in contributing to the critical processes related to the successfully held June 2022 ZICA examinations. The Institute looks forward to the continued beneficial partnership with the approved Tuition providers and examination centres in the development of work-ready Accountants and business leaders.

In this statement on the release of the June 2022 examination results, we will reflect on developments related to the following key matters:

1.0 EXAMINATION ENTRIES

I wish to start with highlighting details about entries for the June 2022 examinations.

A total of 4,325 entries were recorded for the June 2022 examinations compared to 2,367 entries recorded in March 2022.

Of the 4,325 entries for the June 2022 examinations, 464 entries were absent from the examinations representing an absenteeism rate of 10.7% compared to 13.8% in March 2022. Students are urged to attempt the examinations they pay for so that they complete their studies on time and contribute to Zambia and the world's development.

Of the 3,861 entries present in the examination, 2,481 entries were male candidates, representing 64.3% of the entries compared to 65.9% in March 2022 while 1,380 entries were female candidates representing 35.7% of the entries compared to 34.1% in March 2022. There was a decline in terms of percentage in the number of male candidates in the March 2022 session, while a slight increase was recorded for their female counterparts.

2.0 PERFORMANCE

I will now highlight the performance of the candidates that sat for the June 2022 Examinations.

Overall Pass Rates

During the June 2022 Examination session, it was observed that overall pass rates for all qualifications and levels recorded a rise, except for the CA Certificate in Accountancy level of the CA Zambia and Certificate in Taxation when compared to the March 2022 session (and December 2021 session for the Taxation and PSFM qualifications). The highest pass rate recorded during the session was the 100% for the Diploma in Public Sector Financial Management qualification while the lowest was 36.3% recorded in the CA Advisory Professional in Accountancy level of the CA Zambia qualification. Summary of the pass rates in comparison to March 2022 was as shown in the table below:

Pass Rates by Gender

During the June 2022 Examination Session, it was observed that male candidates have continued to out-perform their female counterparts in all qualifications. The pass rates by gender were as follows:

Pass Rates by Mode of Study

During the June 2022 examination session, it was observed that the best performance in the CA Zambia qualification was by students on self-study that led in performance at the first two levels followed by the full time candidates that led in performance at the third level. The self-study students also led in performance in the Certificate in Taxation as well as the Diploma in Public Sector Financial Management qualifications, while the full-time candidates were best performers in both levels of the Diploma in Accountancy qualification. Part-time students led in performance in the Diploma in Taxation qualification.

The comparative pass rates by Study modes are shown below:

Pass Rates by Number of Attempts

During the June 2022 sitting, it was observed that the pass rates of candidates passing on first attempt have continued being highest at all levels of all qualifications examined except for the CA Certificate in Accountancy and CA Application Advanced Diploma in Accountancy (where performance by candidates attempting for the third time was highest).

4.0 HIGHEST SCORES AND OVERALL BEST PERFORMING STUDENTS IN RESPECTIVE PROGRAMMES

Allow me now to highlight the highest scores obtained under each of our programmes to demonstrate how manageable our examinations are with adequate preparation.

4.1 Highest Scores per Programme

• CA Zambia qualification

The highest score on this programme was 92% obtained in CA1.4 - Commercial and Corporate Law at the Certificate in Accountancy level.

• Diploma in Accountancy

The programme had the highest score of 90% obtained in DA10 – Taxation at level 2.

• Taxation

The highest score on this programme was 87% obtained in C5 - Indirect Taxes at the Certificate in Taxation level.

• Diploma in Public Sector Financial Management

The programme had the highest score of 71% obtained in PFM2 - Legal Aspects of Public Sector Finance and Administration.
